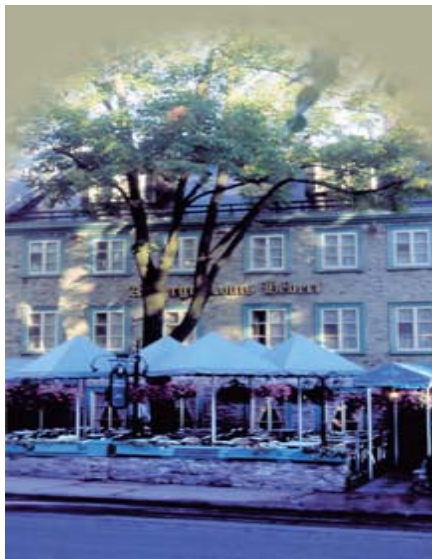


Restaurant Pub D'Orsay
